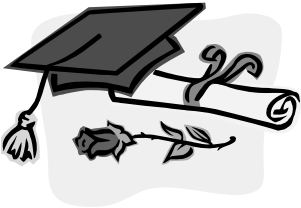

Power99 Personality to Keynote Anniversary Luncheon

Tiffany Bacon, host of Inner City on Power99 FM, is the keynote speaker for the Lawnside Scholarship Club's 60th anniversary celebration at 1 p.m. on Saturday, May 21 at Vitarelli's Grand Ballroom in Oaklyn.

Tickets for the luncheon are \$40 for adults. High school underclassmen and college students may pay \$22. Graduating high school seniors attend free as guests of the Club. They also participate in the Salute to Seniors, a tradi-

tion started 30 years ago, to honor our graduates with lunch, inspiring words and a small gift.

Helen Jay, a member with more than 30 years of service to the Club, is luncheon chairperson. Elva Mitchell, another long-time member, is co-chair.

Students with the highest averages will receive a total of \$5,750. More than \$6,350 in community, civic and individual awards will also be presented.

Miss Bacon, a North Philadelphia native, attend-

ed Temple University for both undergraduate and graduate work. As an underclassman at Temple, Miss Bacon served as a panelist on 6 ABC's weekly program "Youth Perspective."

In 1991, she started out at 90.1 FM Temple University's radio station then moved to B101.1 FM in 1995. She landed at

About the Club

The Lawnside Scholarship Club was founded in 1945 to award scholarships to deserving local residents who plan to pursue higher education or trade school.

The first award was for \$50. Today the Club gives scholarships to students with the four highest averages, plus a \$500 award to anyone with an average over 93. We offer book awards to students already enrolled in college who maintain a semester or cumulative g.p.a. of 2.75 and provide aid for hardship cases.



Who is Eligible for Top Awards?

Graduating seniors who have resided in Lawnside for at least two years before graduation, who are legally enrolled in the schools they are attending.
